The New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD) Medical Assistance Division is providing this notice of opportunity to comment on a proposed Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State Plan Amendment (SPA) 21-0009, which updates the original March 1999 state plan.

Effective October 1, 2021 the New Mexico Human Services Department proposes to implement updates to outdated language and include new strategic objectives, performance goals and plan administration to the CHIP SPA. The changes will align language with current eligibility standards for the state's Medicaid mandatory and optional eligibility groups under Title XXI of the Social Security Act Section 1902 (e)(14), 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 457.40 (b) and provisions of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). This amendment does not make changes to eligibility, benefits or payment methodology. There is no anticipated financial impact.
