**RE: Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments Letter 24-30: SPA 24-0015, Adult Accredited Residential Treatment Centers (AARTC) Fee Schedule**

Dear Tribal Leadership, Indian Health Service, Tribal Health Providers, and Other Interested Parties:

Seeking advice and comments from New Mexico's Indian Nations, Tribes, Pueblos and their health care providers is an important component of the government-to-government relationship with the State of New Mexico. In accordance with the New Mexico's Health Care Authority (HCA) Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments process, this letter is to inform you that the HCA, through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is accepting comments until **5:00 p.m. Mountain Time (MT) January 30, 2025**, regarding state plan amendment (SPA) 24-0015, Adult Accredited Residential Treatment Centers (AARTC) Fee Schedule.

Effective January 1, 2025, New Mexico Medicaid will implement fee schedule rates for AARTCs.

The New Mexico HCA is proposing to move away from cost-based reimbursement for AARTCs and to a prospective fee schedule rate. This rate is developed based on a comprehensive analysis of facility cost report data and is based on a weighted average. Facilities with an approved cost-based rate that exceeds the fee schedule rate may be held harmless of these changes.

**Tribal Impact**

The HCA anticipates a positive financial impact for Indian Nations, Tribes, and Pueblos and their health care providers with this change.
