RE: Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments Letter 24-29: Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) Reimbursement

Dear Tribal Leadership, Indian Health Service, Tribal Health Providers, and Other Interested Parties:

Seeking advice and comments from New Mexico's Indian Nations, Tribes, Pueblos and their health care providers is an important component of the government-to-government relationship with the State of New Mexico. In accordance with the New Mexico's Health Care Authority (HCA) Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments process, this letter is to inform you that the HCA, through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is accepting comments until 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time (MT) **January 31, 2025**, regarding State Plan Amendment (SPA) 24-0014, Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) Reimbursement.

Effective January 1, 2025, in accordance with Section 5121 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act (2023), New Mexico MAD will cover Targeted Case Management to adjudicated justice-involved youth, 30 days pre- and post-release from public institutions. Eligible juveniles include youth up to age 21, and former foster care youth ages 18 to 26. TCM services will be reimbursed through the methodology described in 4.19-B, Item X, of the proposed New Mexico Medicaid SPA.

Tribal Impact

The HCA does not anticipate any impact for Indian Nations, Tribes, and Pueblos and their health care providers with this change.
