## **ISD2** Overview

- ◆ 25<sup>+</sup> year old technology
- Data storage and retrieval method
  - Not a relational database
  - Significantly increases the complexity level and time of any data extract or system change compared with more contemporary technologies
- Duplication of data entry task for a minimum of each one of the three major programs served by ISD
- Unable to implement some new programs in the legacy system

# **IT Projects**

#### ISD2R

- Support worker functions such as intake, interviewing, case assignment, scheduling, eligibility determination, benefits calculation, benefit recovery, and various quality control and reporting functions.
- Interfaces with YES-NM
- ➤ Total costs through 2013 \$66.1 million (federal and general funds)
  - FY10: \$14.364 (\$6.4 general funds)
  - FY 11 request: \$22.4 million (\$10.1 general funds)
- Business Intelligence Tool
  - Phase 1: Tentative completion January 2010
    - Day-old reporting from the existing ISD2 and LIHEAP data
    - Management information for ISD Central office, Regional Managers and County Directors
    - Real-time adhoc query capability
    - Preliminary reports will require extensive testing for accuracy
  - Subsequent phases will be implemented with the ISD2R project
- Document Imaging
  - Final phase of selection via RFP
  - Auto acceptance of applications from YES-NM
  - Image repository for all clients documents
- Encounter Tracking
  - Client to be tracked through an ISD high-volume front office from walking up to the greeter to the finish of the encounter, showing progress along the way

### **House Memorial 125**

- House Memorial 125 Monthly Medicaid and CHIPRA Reports
  - Passed in 2009 Legislative Session
  - Sponsored by Representative Mimi Stewart
- HSD to make monthly reports and retain documentation regarding the Medicaid and CHIPRA programs.



## **House Memorial 125**

- Reports are to include:
  - Annual budget projections and expenditures by category of eligibility
  - Monthly point-in-time numbers of enrolled recipients
    - Listed by category of eligibility
    - Show the actual enrollment of Medicaid and CHIPRA at time of reporting
  - Monthly denial rates
    - Number of applications received
    - Number of applications approved
    - Number of applications denied, with denial code
  - Termination rates
    - Number of cases due for renewal
    - Number of renewals received
    - Number of renewals denied
    - Number of recipients whose case was terminated, with termination code
    - Number of recipients disenrolled and reinstated within six months

## **YES-New Mexico Overview and Demo**

- ◆ YES-New Mexico is a web based system available to the public which allows individuals and families to access income support programs.
  - > Seven state agencies involved, currently screening for five programs
  - Eventually interface with the ISD2 Replacement System
  - > Phasing YES-NM; first counties are Valencia, Guadalupe, and DeBaca
  - > Statewide unveiling tentatively late October, early November
  - Screening tool tells people what programs they may be eligible for
    - Screening tool became available July 29, 2009
  - > Application tool allows people to apply online to programs
    - Not yet operational; finishing final review
    - Applications will be reviewed and processed at Income Support Division Office
  - 12 demos around New Mexico to legislators, state agencies, advocates, and the public
