HSD Initiatives

Assistance Division (MAD) of the New Mexico Human Service Department unbundled Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) drugs and devices from FQHC, RHC and HB-RHC rates.



HSD initiatives continued

- HSD does not require a Prior Authorization (PA) for LARCs.
 - 2 MCOs do not require a PA for LARCs
 - 2 MCOs do not require a PA for the medical side and are working on removing the PA for the pharmacy side.



HSD initiatives continued

MCO contracts contain a new tracking measure requiring the MCO to measure the use of Long Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARC) among members age 15 through 19.



HSD initiatives continued

HSD continues to be actively engaged with the statewide LARC workgroup facilitated by Young Women United (YWU), and the Association of State and Territorial Health Officials (ASTHO) LARC learning community.
