The New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA) Medical Assistance Division (MAD) is providing notice on plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to update the Amount Would Otherwise Paid (AWOP) methodology for the Program of all Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) program. This methodology is developed in accordance with the CMS rate setting guide. They are developed prospectively on a per member per month (PMPM) basis and are updated annually.
