2. **Reporting requirements:** MCOs are expected to complete and submit the attached report on a quarterly basis as described in the HB53 Reporting template instructions.

  - b. **First Submission:** First submission of this report will be due July 30, 2024, and will include data from Q1CY24 and Q2CY24.

This LOD will sunset upon completion of the Centennial Care 2.0 Program on June 30, 2024.
