## **Interested Parties:**

The Human Services Department (the Department), Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is seeking approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services regarding amendments to New Mexico's Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) 1915(c) Waivers: Developmental Disabilities Waiver (DDW) NM.0173.R07.06; Medically Fragile Waiver (MFW) NM.0223.R06.06; and Mi Via Waiver NM.0448.R03.06.

The State intends to submit the amendments to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) on July 19, 2024, to implement rate increases as recommended through the Department of Health, Developmental Disabilities and Supports Division rate study completed in 2023.

The key components of proposed changes under the waiver amendments are as follows:

Developmental Disabilities Waiver (DDW) NM.0173.R07.06: Implement rate increase funded through state fiscal year 2024 legislative appropriation for the following services: Behavioral Support Consultation Standard; Behavioral Support Consultation Incentive; Case Management Ongoing; Community Integrated Employment Job Maintenance; Customized Community Support Individual; Customized Community Support Group Category 1; Customized Community Group Category 2 Extensive Support; Family Living; Supported Living Category 4 Extraordinary Medical/Behavioral Support; Adult Nursing Services RN; Adult Nursing Services LPN; Respite; Socialization and Sexuality Education Standard; Socialization and Sexuality Education Incentive; Occupational Therapy Standard; Occupational Therapy Incentive; Occupational Therapy Assistant Standard; Physical Therapy Standard; Physical Therapy Incentive; Physical Therapy Assistant Incentive; Speech Language Pathology Standard; Speech Language Pathology Incentive; and Environmental Modifications. Updates were made to Appendix 1-2a, J-2-c-i, and J-2c-d waiver years 4-5.

Medically Fragile Waiver (MFW) NM.0223.R06.06: Implement rate increase funded through state fiscal year 2024 legislative appropriation for the following services: Case Management Ongoing; Home Health Aide; Private Duty Nursing RN; Private Duty Nursing LPN; Respite Home Health Aide; Respite Home Health Aide; Respite LPN; Respite RN; and Environmental Modifications. Updates were made to Appendix 1-2a, J-2-c-I, and J-2c-d waiver years 4-5.

<u>Mi Via Waiver NM.0448.R03.06:</u> Implement rate increase funded through state fiscal year 2024 legislative appropriation for the following services: Behavioral Support Consultation; Behavior Support Consultation Incentive; Community Direct Support; Customized Community Group

Supports; Consultant Services; In-Home Living Supports; Private Duty Nursing Adults RN; Respite Standard; Physical Therapy; Physical Therapy Incentive; Occupational Therapy; Occupational Therapy Incentive; Speech Language Pathology; Speech Language Pathology Incentive; Transportation Mile; and Environmental Modifications. Updates were made to Appendix 1-2a, J-2-c-I, and J-2c-d waiver years 4-5.
