Interested Parties:

The New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD), through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is providing this notice of opportunity to comment on proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) 23-0006 Evidence-Based Practices (EBP). **Second Public Comment Period.**

Effective July 1, 2023 New Mexico is updating its state plan to include community-based mobile crisis intervention services authorized by section 9813 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and to incorporate additional evidenced-based practices including Functional Family Therapy, Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy, Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing, and Dialectical Behavior Therapy. Language is also being added to update the Multi-Systemic Therapy service and Peer Support providers. Additionally, language is added to allow involuntary admission to Crisis Triage Centers in alignment with the Senate Bill 310 (SB310) that was passed by the New Mexico Legislature in the 2023 Legislative Session.

The estimated total financial impact is \$628,001 in federal funds for FFY 23 and \$2,512,005 in federal funds for FFY 24.
