RE: Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments Letter 24-23: SPA 24-0011, Program of All Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) Methodology language Update

Dear Tribal Leadership, Indian Health Service, Tribal Health Providers, and Other Interested Parties:

Seeking advice and comments from New Mexico's Indian Nations, Tribes, Pueblos and their health care providers is an important component of the government-to-government relationship with the State of New Mexico. In accordance with the New Mexico's Health Care Authority (HCA) Tribal Notification to Request Advice and Comments process, this letter is to inform you that the HCA, through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), is accepting comments until 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time (MT) **November 25, 2024** regarding State Plan Amendment (SPA) 24-0011, Program of All Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) methodology language update.

Effective November 1, 2024, New Mexico Medicaid will update the Amount Would Otherwise Have Been Paid (AWOP) methodology. This methodology is developed in accordance with the CMS rate setting guide. They are developed prospectively on a per member per month (PMPM) basis and are updated annually.

## **Tribal Impact**

The HCA does not anticipate any impact for Indian Nations, Tribes, and Pueblos and their health care providers with this change.
